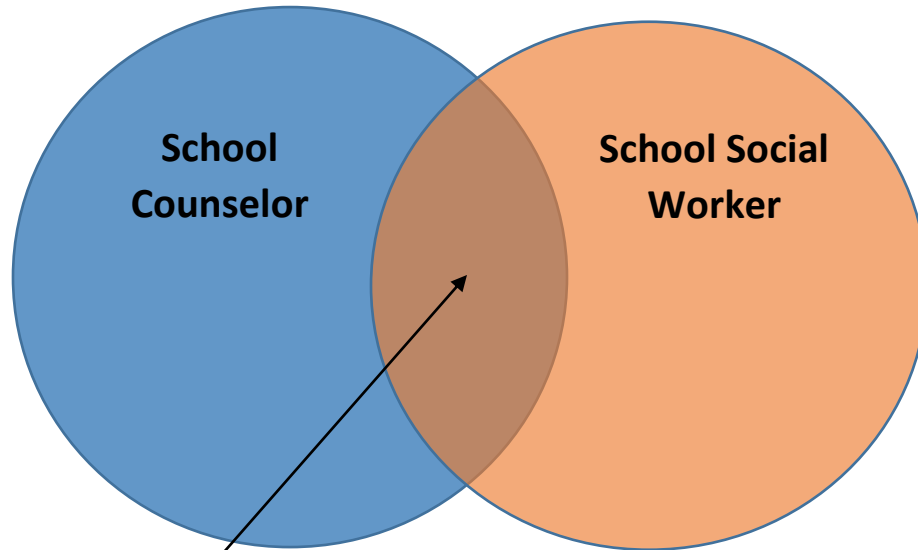


Overlapping and Unique Roles of ESA Student Support Staff



School Counselor

- Student Advocacy
- No more than 3 lessons of core Academic, SEL and Career curriculum per grade level
- New Student Orientation and Transition services (5th to 6th, 8th to 9th)
- MTSS Structured Tiered Short-term (6 to 8 sessions) individual and small groups Interventions
- Address equity by addressing systemic and processes in need of change
- Parent Workshops on Career, College, Financial Aid, Academics and Transitions (5th to 6th, 8th to 9th)
- Do not provide 'case management'
- Do provide Tier 2 and 3 services per WA School Counseling Model

School Social Worker

- Home-School-Community Liaison
- Leadership and guidance in the formation of discipline and behavioral procedures
- Assessment/Teacher Collaborations
- Direct Services (individual/group behavioral and mental health services, social & emotional learning)
- Professional Case Management
- Collaboration with other educational professionals, organizations, and community agencies
- Consultation, development, and implementation of (Positive) Behavior Intervention Plans
